

Why are we doing Remote Learning?

We are doing Remote Learning to stay healthy and prevent the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) by practicing social distancing and avoiding gatherings of more than 10 people.



How is the Remote Learning day structured?

The Remote Learning day of middle school students is structured in the same way as if you were in school except that you will transition between Google Classrooms for each of your classes instead.

- You must follow an A or B schedule based on your instructional group.
- You must visit your House Google Classroom to confirm your attendance at 8:25.
- You will complete assignments for 3 classes in the morning.
- You will take a break for lunch from 12:10 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- You will complete an assignment for period 4 in the afternoon.
- You will complete an assignment for studio from 2:05 to 2:50 p.m.
- You will finish the day by writing the daily reflection by 3:30 p.m.

How will we take your attendance for Remote Learning?



In addition, we will monitor your attendance to classes through your participation in Google Classroom.



How should you setup your Remote Learning space?

Just like in school, you will need a quiet space to work. You should also set up yourself on a desk or table so you can organize your materials. Turn off the television, video games, and any other electronics that could be distracting.



What will you need to take part in Remote Learning?

You will need a charged Chromebook to take part in instruction every Remote Learning day. You will also need your math notebook, class novel, pencils, and math workbook.



How will you be evaluated during Remote Learning?

Each day you will complete assignments on Google Classroom to earn classwork points. In addition, you will complete projects, essays, presentations and quizzes that will be graded. Assignments will be graded in Google Classroom and posted on PowerSchool.
